Dear Parents / Carers,

### **Year 3 Visit to Creswell Crags - Friday 5<sup>th</sup> December 2025**

As part of our class topic, the Year 3 children will be visiting Creswell Crags on Friday the 5<sup>th</sup> December.

Creswell Crags is a limestone gorge, honeycombed with caves and smaller fissures. Stone tools, and remains of animals found in the caves, provide evidence of a fascinating story of life during the last Ice Age, between 50,000 and 10,000 years ago. Further evidence came to light in 2003 with the discovery of Britain's only known Ice Age rock art. The children will take part in some exciting activities during their visit.

The children will leave school at 9:00am, by coach, and will return to school at around 3.30pm. Please ensure your child arrives for school on time that morning so they can be registered before they leave.

A packed lunch will be needed, along with a water bottle. If you have ordered a hot meal with Good Lookin' Cookin' (GLC) for that day, it will be replaced with a cold box. Alternatively, you can cancel the meal with GLC and send your child with a packed lunch to take with them.

Children will be required to wear appropriate clothing for being outside and going inside caves, e.g., warm trousers, sturdy shoes (such as walking boots or trainers), plenty of layers, and a waterproof coat. Also, if your child suffers from travel sickness, please ensure that they have taken their medication prior to arriving at school, and that one dose of labelled medication for the return journey is handed to the class teacher on the morning of the visit.

The cost of the trip is £24.00 per child, which includes entry to the venue and transport. Payment can be made via the Arbor app.
