

French

We will be learning the French alphabet through song and will then be decoding messages using French words. We will be also be learning about Easter traditions in France and comparing their festivities with England.

Science

During this term we will be exploring the properties of materials. We will be finding out about and experimenting with electrical and thermal insulators and conductors. We will then move on to exploring mixtures through dissolving, separating, filtering and sieving.

PE

This term we will be developing our dance skills by performing actions with increased control. We will be improvising routines and developing formations to dance expressively. We will also be honing our striking and fielding skills.

Music

This term we will be honing our singing skills in our production 'Crikey, Moses!'

CURRICULUM OFFER YEAR 5 SPRING 2 2019

English

In English, we return to narrative writing, this term using David Wiesner's 'Tuesday' as stimulus. We will be focussing on improving our vocabulary and ensuring it is used effectively in our writing.

Our Guided Reading text continues with the varied stories of 'Incredible Quests'. This term we will be reading the information text 'Wild Animals Are Not Pets' and discussing the ethical dilemmas contained within.

History

We will be finding out about Roman Gods and Goddesses, and explain the significance of Roman baths, the amenities that they contained and their importance. This will link into our Roman Lincoln trip, where we will discover the role the city played in Roman times.



Trips and Visits

During this term, Year 5 will be learning all about the rich Roman history of Lincoln. We will be having a guided tour of Roman Lincoln. Alistair MacIntosh – the City Archaeologist will be facilitating our exploration of Roman artefacts that have been discovered in the city, explaining how they were discovered and teaching us about the technology that is used to establish where these artefacts were found. We will also be thinking about what fascinating artefacts could be under our feet and how archaeologists date these discoveries.

Maths

This term we will further develop our understanding of fractions, multiplying fractions and calculating fractions of amounts. We will also be using fractions as operators and completing mixed word problems that involve fractions. We will then move on to decimals; writing, rounding, ordering and comparing. We will end the term thinking about equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages.

Design & Technology

We will be designing and creating an Easter themed fabric bag. We will begin by deconstructing a bag in order to write instructions. We will also be learning different stitches and will finish by adding a final applique detail.
