This term, we will be continuing to study 'An Eagle in the Snow' and using this to learn more about the implications of the end of World War 1 and how this contributed to the start of World War 2.

Trips and Visits:

27th February 2018: Visit to 'The Journey' exhibition (National Holocaust Centre, Ollerton)

The Journey exhibition follows the story of Leo Stein, a 10 year old German Jewish boy, living with his parents and younger sister Hannah. The Steins live in Berlin, Germany in 1938, during the year which we follow his life many things changed for Leo and his family, as it did for other Jewish people.

Science

During this term, we will continue to explore the topic of light. We will be investigating how light enables us to see colours and why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them.

Maths:

We will be calculating the area of a triangle, parallelogram and composite shapes. We will also be exploring ratio and proportion, scale factors, using a protractor to measure angles, calculating missing angles and statistics.

We will also explore the changing lives of women and children during this time. As well as this, we will compare the every day life of people during World War Two with modern day life.
