



## French

In French, we will be learning all about ice-cream flavours, using our prior knowledge of number to order accurate amounts of ice-cream in role play. We will then move on to learning about Christmas celebrations in France, comparing the similarities and differences between celebrations in France and England.

## Science

During this term we will be exploring forces and their effect upon objects. Children will identify and name different forces including gravity, friction, air resistance and water resistance, carrying out investigations to explore these forces and working scientifically to discuss different variables.

## PE

This term we will be working on developing our dancing skills. We will specifically look to maintain rhythm whilst changing direction, creating sequences of movements and choreographing routines with a partner or group.

## Music

We will be recognising the basic style indicators of old-school hip-hop.

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## English

In our English this term, we will be returning to narrative writing, using the Pixar animation 'Home Sweet Home' as stimulus. We will be using our newly-acquired year 5 skills to make our writing detailed and descriptive.

Our Guided Reading text moves on to 'Below Deck – A Titanic Story', where we will be introduced to Grace and Auntie Nora, two characters on the maiden voyage of Titanic, bound for New York.

## Geography

We will continue our geography work exploring mountains of the world, thinking about mountain ranges within the UK and comparing them to Mount Everest. We will also be using maps and atlases to locate the world's



## Trips and Visits

## Maths

This term we will be developing our understanding of statistics, including reading and interpreting data presented in graphs and tables.

We will then return to multiplication and division, strengthening our understanding and applying our mathematical skills to word problems. We will end the term learning about measure, focussing on calculating area and perimeter.

## RE

This term we will be learning more about the Islamic faith, thinking about how Muslims demonstrate their commitment to God.

## ICT

In computing, we will be investigating code and understanding why some information is sent in this way. We will explore cipher code, creating our own code to make messages more secure.
