This term, we will be studying the disputable story of the man who could have stopped World War Two. A beautiful moral thriller from one of the world's favourite storytellers that will be used to inspire our reading and writing this term.



Religious Education:

We will continue to investigate our big question 'Do you have to believe in God to be good?' by exploring Buddhist and Humanist beliefs. We will then move on to explore the big question 'Creation and Science: conflicting or complementary?'

Trips and Visits:

We will be researching the contribution of Lincolnshire during WWI when we visit to The Lincolnshire Life Museum.

During this term, we are excited to invite Michael Credland (historian, author and designer of the Tritton Road tank memorial) into Year 6.

Science

During this term, we will be exploring the topic of light. Pupils will begin by investigating how light travels in straight lines, and how mirrors reflect light to help us to see objects. We will also investigate how refraction changes the direction in which light travels and how a prism changes a ray of light.



Maths:

We will be exploring the link between fractions, decimals and percentages during this term, including multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000; multiplying and dividing decimals and expressing fractions as decimals.
