B E T W E E N LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL of County Offices Newland
in the City of Lincoln (hereinafter called "the Council") of the one
part and THE LINCOLN DIOCESAN TRUST AND BOARD OF FINANCE LIMITED whose
registered office is situate at The Old Palace in the City of Lincoln
(hereinafter called "the Diocesan Trust") of the other part

W H E R E A S :

- (i) The Council is successor in title to the Mayor Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Lincoln by virtue of the provisions of the Local Government Act 1972
- (ii) The Council is seised in fee simple in possession free from incumbrances of the land described in the Schedule hereto
- (iii) The Council as the Local Education Authority for the County of Lincolnshire is required to provide the said land as a new site for the Lincoln St. Faith's Church of England Middle School (which said School was formerly called Lincoln St. Faith's Church of England Junior School and is hereinafter called "the School") to be held on the trusts hereinafter declared
- (iv) By an Order of the Secretary of State for Education and Science dated the Thirtieth day of April One thousand nine hundred and seventy the said Secretary of State authorised the transfer of the School to the said new site
- (v) The School is a Controlled School within the meaning of the Education Act 1944 and the Diocesan Trust is the Trustee thereof

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH that in consideration of these presents the Council as Beneficial Owner in exercise of its statutory powers hereby conveys unto the Diocesan Trust ALL THAT the said land described in the Schedule hereto TO HOLD the same unto the Diocesan Trust in fee simple in trust for the purposes of a voluntary school within the meaning of the Education Acts 1944 to 1980 for the education of children living

in or near to the Parish of Lincoln Saint Faith and Saint Martin with Saint Peter at Arches wherein religious instruction shall be given in accordance with the doctrine of the Church of England

IN WITNESS whereof the Council and the Diocesan Trust have caused their respective Common Seals to be hereunto affixed the day and year first above written

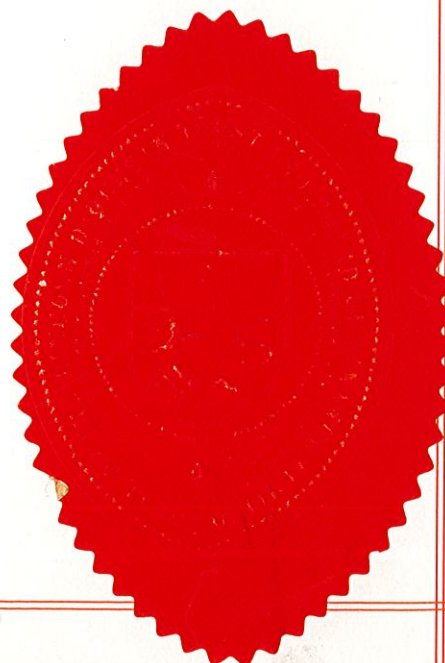
