We firmly believe in the value of a school uniform. It generates a sense of pride and belonging, sets the tone of the school and is a great leveller, being the same for everyone.

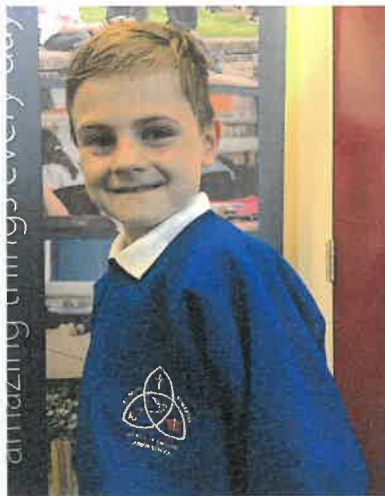


GIRLS

- Grey or black skirt, trousers or shorts
- White shirt or polo shirt (plain or with logo)
- Plain grey or black tights/socks
- Royal blue sweatshirt/cardigan/fleece (plain or with logo)
- Blue and white checked summer dresses
- Plain black, flat shoes which have straps or laces (no slip-ons)

BOYS

- Grey/black trousers or shorts
- White shirt or polo shirt (plain or with logo)
- Plain grey or black socks
- Royal blue sweatshirt or fleece (plain or with logo)
- Plain black, flat shoes which have straps or laces (no slip-ons)



PE Kit

Please encourage your child to bring their PE kits to school on a Monday, and take it home again on a Friday to be washed.

WHAT DO I NEED?

A small PE bag containing:

- Black or navy shorts
- White t-shirt or polo shirt
- Plimsolls
- Trainers (for outdoor PE)
- Black or navy jogging bottoms (for winter)
- Black or navy sweatshirt (for winter)
- Optional SFSM hoodie, available from Uniform Direct



SAFETY WITH EARRINGS

- Plain stud earrings are allowed if your child has pierced ears.
- All stud earrings should be removed for PE lessons. If your child has problems removing or replacing earrings, we do ask that they are not worn on PE days.
- We suggest that new piercings are done at the beginning of summer holidays please.
- If earrings can not be removed temporarily, please send a letter listing the date when they can be removed. Class teachers will provide microporous tape to cover the earrings in the meantime.

KEEPING THE FOCUS ON LEARNING
